**PLEASE TAKE ADVANTAGE OF YOUR PRIORITY STATUS.
Open registration for the community will begin March 1st.**

Association church members and families with children currently enrolled are granted priority registration status. Registration will begin **February 1st**. The fee will be \$50.00 per child during the month of February. Families with multiple children may stagger this enrollment fee an additional month per child with administrative permission only. Registration fee will increase to \$100.00 per child on March 1st. This fee is not part of tuition. Registration fee will continue to increase \$50.00 per month through August. Full registration information will be mailed to each family before February 1.

- 1st Child \$3700.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$411.11
- 2nd Child \$3200.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$355.55
- 3rd Child + Additional \$2700.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$300.00

HIGH SCHOOL TUITION – LSA MEMBER

(LSA Church Member & LSA 8th Grade Family)

- 1st Child \$3800.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$422.22
- 2nd Child \$3100.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$344.44
- 3rd Child + Additional \$1800.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$200.00

HIGH SCHOOL TUITION – NON-MEMBER

- 1st Child \$4800.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$533.33
- 2nd Child \$4100.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$455.55
- 3rd Child + Additional \$2800.00 yearly – payable in up to 9 payments of \$311.11

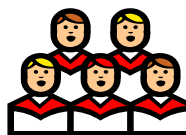
