FOR YOUR HEALTH...



Flu season is definitely upon us and continues to be a reality here at LSA. We have one more confirmed case of the H1N1 flu. We share this with you to inform you, not to cause alarm or panic. We are continuing to take steps to reduce the spread of illness, but we need your continued assistance in doing so.

It is very important that you closely monitor your student's health. Please keep him/her home from school should they exhibit any flu-like symptoms. Symptoms of the flu include:

We are asking any students and staff experiencing two or more of these symptoms to:

- Stay at home until symptom free,
- Seek care/advice of a physician,
- Report the illness/symptoms to the school office,
- Stay home for at least 24 hours after experiencing fever of 100 degrees or higher. (fever free without fever-reducing medicine)

At LSA, maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment for our students is a top priority. We will continue to take the following actions:

- Students with a temperature of 100 or more will be sent home immediately.
- Encouraging preventative measures such as frequent hand washing, covering nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing.
- Frequent surface washing of table, door knobs, desks, keyboards, etc.

ACT (No Writing) is \$32.00. Includes reports for you, your high school (if you authorize reporting), and up to four college choices (if valid codes are provided when you register).

ACT Plus Writing is \$47.00. Includes reports for you, your high school (if you authorize reporting), and up to four college choices (if valid codes are provided when you register). The \$15.00 Writing Test fee is refundable, on written request, if you are absent on test day or switch to the ACT (No Writing) before you begin testing

Most high school juniors take the ACT in April. For additional information on the ACT test, go to ACT.org.
