


### The deadline of May 1st is

#### Coffee With Mr. Karsten

If you haven't registered your family for next school year yet, remember that Enrollment Fees are \$150 per student in April and will continue to rise by \$50 each month through August. We use these early enrollment numbers to help make plans for the coming year, including necessary plans for staffing and programs. We also ask that you continue sharing LSA with family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors. We would love to have the opportunity to tour with any new families. I would like to challenge each family to invite one new family to consider touring LSA this week. You could qualify for our Referral Program if the family you refer joins us next school year. We offer \$100 per new student off of your final tuition payment at the end of the year, after the new family has attended that full year. That means if you refer a family with 3 students, that is \$300 off of your tuition next year. There is no limit either, so you can refer more than one family as well. We hope you will consider sharing LSA with one family this week. With so many families, think how our LSA family could grow if even 10% of those referred joined us next year. -Mr. Karsten

### Are your Family Volunteer Hours completed?

### **Lutheran Early Response Team (LERT)**

As many of you are aware, we had nine tornadoes hit the state of Illinois on April 9, 2015, causing significant damage to the town Rochelle and practically destroying the town of Fairdale, Illinois. On April 11, 2015, 2 two days after the tornado outbreak, Lutheran Church Charities (Northern Illinois District) deployed over 270 LERT volunteers to assist in disaster relief. Many of our own LERT Central Illinois District members were also present. At this time, there has been a hold on disaster relief efforts, as the situation needs further assessment. Therefore, we ask that no LERT members deploy until we are given the green light. Once our district coordinators are notified to deploy, we will immediately notify you. It is also important to note that our LERT training on April 18th in Macomb, Illinois is just 10 days after the 2015 Illinois tornado outbreak. Additionally, the devastation was just 61 days after our LERT training on February 7th in Green Valley, Illinois. Here are our two upcoming LERT trainings:
