May Chapel offerings are designated for Joe Boway and the Liberia Children's Ministry.

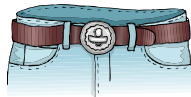
**May 1st is the deadline to apply and submit all information for financial aid for the upcoming school year! Student must be registered to receive aid.**
