And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. <sup>21</sup> God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

In the next few days, you will receive a "mid year survey" that we ask you to complete as we make plans for next year and evaluate LSA. Thank you.

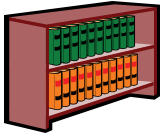
