End of Year Checklist:

- ~ **Pick up any medication left in my office.** If not picked up, it will be taken to the med drop off box at the Decatur Police Station
- ~ **Renew a Medication Authorization form** with your child's doctor prior to next year
- ~ **Schedule your child for a routine physical** if they are upcoming Kindergarten, 6th or 9th graders (this is acceptable for a sports physical)
- ~ **Schedule your child for the recommended vaccinations** for their age
- ~ **Schedule an eye exam** if your child is an incoming Kindergartener
- ~ **Schedule a dental exam** if your child is an incoming Kindergarten, 2nd or 6th grader
- ~ **Enjoy a fun, relaxing, and healthy summer!**
