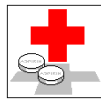

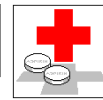

**Your child should stay home from school if:**

- ~fever over 100 degrees in the last 24 hours
- ~stomach flu with vomiting and diarrhea in the last 24 hours
- ~frequent, productive or non-productive, cough that requires medication during the day
- ~cases of strep or pink eye that require antibiotic. Child must have been on antibiotic for 24 hours before return
- ~any illness or injury that hinders your child's ability to learn
